What is New and/or Exciting?

- This year’s theme is “Songfoolery.” All of the musical selections have an element of fantasy, legend or fairy tale – some tell musical stories, others highlight characters or paint scenes. Each level contains a mix of repertoire ranging from classical ballet and symphonic works to contemporary pieces from music theater and popular music.

- There is a minimum age requirement of 6 years old and all younger students performing on late elementary level pieces should be paired with an adult or advanced student at least 12 years of age.
- There will be a student Art Contest for the program cover again this year. Submitted artwork will be displayed at the first rehearsal and every performer will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite. Computer generated graphics **will** be allowed.
